DISCOUNTS & REFUNDS

- 5% Family Discount on the tuition of a second child
- There are **NO CREDITS OR TRANSFERS TO ANOTHER SCHOOL YEAR**. Students who withdraw 30 days into the school year will receive a 50% refund; and any student who withdraws after 31 days receives no refund.
- Please note new policy: Students who miss classes are not eligible for a tuition refund except when due to
 prolonged illness or severe injury, verified by a doctor's confirmation. Then 50% of the tuition due will be
 refunded.

TUITION

- Annual Family Registration Fee: \$35.00 Non-Refundable
- Single Class Rate: \$22.50
- Professional Single Class Rate (with proof of professional status, i.e. union card, etc.): \$20.00
- \$25 Return Check Fee assessment for any returned check

PAYMENT OPTIONS:

• Option 1: Pay School Year Tuition in Full – due on or before 8/15/16

• Option 2: Pay School Year Tuition in two payments – due on or before 8/15/16 and 1/2/17

Please note: each semester payment is a different amount

• **Option 3:** Pay School Year Tuition in 8 equal payments due on or before 9/1/16, 10/1/16, 11/1/16, 12/1/17, 1/2/17, 2/1/17, 3/1/17, and 4/1/17

If paying by Option 3, tuition received 10 days after the due date of each month will have an automatic \$10 late fee. There will be no exceptions! Please remember we do not send tuition bills. Contact Carolyn Cox regarding payment arrangements. A student will not be allowed to continue if there is outstanding tuition for more than 30 days. All tuition, costume payments and performance fees must be paid before student is allowed to participate in spring performances.

Private lessons can be arranged with individual faculty members through the front desk. Teaching fees vary and are paid directly to the faculty member. The private studio rental of \$25/hour is paid to Chamberlain School of Ballet.

SOME THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- ✓ When dropping off your student(s) for classes, please pull up in front of the studio to let them out of the car. To comply with the Plano City Ordinance, please do not linger in the fire lane. Move on immediately and please do not use the handicapped ramp as a parking space.
- ✓ When picking up your student(s) after classes, please park in a designated parking spot and come inside the school to get your child. It is our policy for the children to wait inside the building. Please pick up your student promptly after class.
- ✓ Dance attire is not considered appropriate for street wear. Always have your dancer wear appropriate clothes such as shirts, shorts, skirts, and street shoes (no leotard, tights, and dance shoes) outside the school.
- ✓ Rubber pants, leg warmers, or sweat pants are not permitted in class. Students not in proper dance attire will be asked to observe class.
- ✓ Hair needs to be pulled back away from face and secured neatly. A head band needs to be worn with short hair.

 No jewelry other than pierced ear studs may be worn in class.
- ✓ Students are encouraged not bring any valuable items to the school including jewelry, electronic items, or cell phones. A locker can be rented for \$25 per semester (for students taking 4 or more days a week) but student will need to provide lock.
- ✓ Parents may enter studios by invitation only.

- ✓ Parents who bring small children need to supervise them! Out of consideration for the staff, faculty, and others waiting in the hall, disruptive children will be asked to leave the lobby area. As a social media courtesy, please keep all electronic devises on mute while using in the lobby.
- ✓ Students may not enter class late or leave class without permission. A student who arrives 10 minutes late may observe class but may not participate.
- ✓ Food, drink, or chewing gum is not allowed in the studios. Students are not permitted to play the piano.
- ✓ School information is sent out via emails. Please make sure we have your current email address.
