Tuition: To ensure placement in a workshop, a non-refundable deposit of \$50 is due by June 30, 2017. The deposit will be applied towards the tuition and payment in full must be received by August 1, 2016.

Dress Code:

Female: Female dancers are to wear black leotard (no halter, high cut/French cut style; no side or back cut-outs; no multiple straps, lace, or rhinestone studs; no skirts, please), pink tights and pink leather ballet shoes. Hair must be neatly secured in a bun. Short hair must be secured away from face. Please bring tap shoes if you have them.

Male: Male dancers are to wear white short-sleeve fitted t-shirt, black fitted legging pants or black shorts with white socks; or black tights with no socks, and black ballet shoes. Please bring tap shoes if you have them.
