DISCOUNTS, REFUNDS & MISSED CLASSES

- 5% Family Discount on the tuition of a second child
- There are NO REFUNDS, CREDITS OR TRANSFERS TO ANOTHER SEMESTER. Once classes have begun
 tuition is not refundable. Students who miss classes or withdraw before the end of the semester are still
 obligated for the full semester's tuition.
- Students who miss classes are not eligible for a tuition refund except when due to prolonged illness or severe injury and verified by a doctor's confirmation. Then 50% of the tuition due will be due.
- Students are allowed to make-up a maximum of 2 unexcused classes missed per semester depending on class availability.

TUITION

- Single Class Rate: \$22.50
- Professional Single Class Rate (with proof of professional status, i.e. union card, etc.): \$20.00
- \$25 Return Check Fee assessment for any returned check

PAYMENT OPTIONS:

• Option 1: Pay School Year Tuition in Full – due on or before 8/15/20

• Option 2: Pay School Year Tuition in two payments – due on or before 8/15/20 and 1/4/21

Option 3: Pay School Year Tuition in 8 equal payments due on or before 8/17/20, 9/17/20, 10/17/20,

11/17/20 for Semester I and 1/17/21, 2/17/21, 3/17/21, and 4/17/21 for Semester II.

If paying by Option 3, tuition received 10 days after the due date of each month will have an automatic \$10 late fee assessed. There will be no exceptions! Please remember we do not send tuition bills. Contact Carolyn Cox regarding payment arrangements. A student will not be allowed to continue if there is outstanding tuition for more than 30 days. All tuition, costume payments and performance fees must be paid before student is allowed to participate in spring performances.

Private lessons can be arranged with individual faculty members through the front desk. Teaching fees vary and are paid directly to the faculty member. The private studio rental of \$25/hour is paid to Chamberlain School of Ballet.

AT THIS TIME COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS ARE IN PLACE:

- As the waiting room and lobby are closed, only students are allowed in the building. Students are to arrive on time and are encouraged to wait in your car until 5-15 minutes prior to the start of class.
- Students will line up outside their assigned entrance door 5-15 minutes prior to class. Signage and markings will be clearly posted as to which door to enter and exit the studio. Once class has begun, students arriving late will not be allowed to enter class, NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Students are asked to arrive wearing a facemask or loose-fitting bandana and keep it on while they dance in the classroom. Please bring your/their own water bottle, as the public water foundation is off-limits. Those students with allergies may prefer to bring their own box of tissues (labeled with name). Students are asked to bring a large towel or mat to be used when warming up/floor stretching.
- Upon entering student's assigned classroom, use hand sanitizer and bring in their dance bag with their supplies.
 Come dressed in your dance attire since all dressing rooms are closed (no students are allowed in dressing rooms).
- Students will wipe down the barre they will be using.
- Bathroom breaks are limited to one student dismissed at a time. Each classroom has a designated bathroom.
- Parents are asked to be 5 minutes early to pick up their student. Parents are to wait inside their car for their student. Note: The instructors will be needing to prepare for their next class and will not be able to oversee students who are waiting for their ride. Students needing to wait on their rise are to wait in the front glass room and exit the front door.

Keeping everyone safe:

- The public water fountain is off limits
- The school is professionally cleaned 6 nights per week. The barres, door handles, and light switches are wiped down before and after every class.
- The air conditioning units have been serviced and treated to kill fungus, bacteria, germs and viruses. Air ventilation will be used during all classes.
- All classrooms will be treated nightly with UV lamps as recommended by CSB's medical advisor.

SOME THINGS TO REMEMBER:

- ✓ When dropping off your student(s) for classes, please pull up in front of the studio to let them out of the car. To comply with the Plano City Ordinance, please do not linger in the fire lane. Move on immediately and please do not use the handicapped ramp as a parking space.
- ✓ Dance attire is not considered appropriate for street wear. Always have your dancer wear appropriate clothes such as shirts, shorts, skirts, and street shoes (over their dance attire) outside the school.
- ✓ Rubber pants or sweat pants are not permitted in class. Leg warmers are permitted in cases of minor injury. Students not in proper dance attire will be asked to observe class.
- ✓ Hair needs to be pulled back away from face and secured neatly. A head band needs to be worn with short hair.

 No jewelry other than pierced ear studs may be worn in class.
- ✓ Food, drink, or chewing gum is not allowed in the studios. Students are not permitted to play the pianos.
- School information is sent out via emails. Please make sure we have your current email address.
